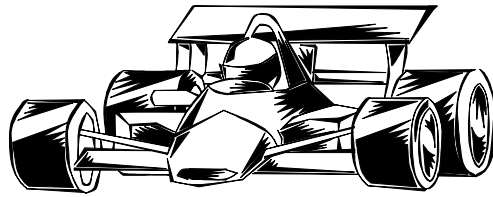

TOT District Rules are strictly followed. Follow rules from BSA Pinewood Derby Box Kit. Axle location cannot be changed from original grooves! See below for details.

Car number 4 is the alternate and only races if one of the top three is not able to compete in the main race.

The alternate car #4 doesn't race in the main race. The alternate will be able to have a race after the official derby race is done. The time for this alternate race is estimated to be at 11:30 am.

TOT District Rules are strictly followed. Please be sure these rules are communicated to parents and scouts.
Trail of Tears District Pinewood Derby Rules

- ✱ All cars- **MUST** be built to the rules and specifications included with the kit. In addition to these rules- the axles **MAY NOT** be moved from their pre-positioned spots. Lengthening or shortening of the axle wheelbase will be cause for disqualification. The cars may not be made longer or wider than the block of wood included in the kit with the wheels attached.
- ✱ Cars **MUST** be built by the boys with the assistance of the parents. This is a cub activity and the boys take great pride with their creations. Please let your boy do the work with your help.
- ✱ Previous years cars are ineligible- a new car must be built each year by all participants.
- ✱ Use only axles & tires from the kit provided- **Hobby Lobby sell parts that are not Cub Scout legal**. Do not substitute axles or wheels or change the shape of the wheels in any way. Wheels may not be sanded or rounded. Only burrs may be removed.
- ✱ The top three racers from each Pack will be eligible for the District Race. You may send a 4th as an alternate in the event one of the top three do not make the race but they will not compete if your top three racers all show.
- ✱ Have fun building and racing!

Pinewood Derby Race Tracks options:

Our district is very fortunate to have several resources for our packs to be able to have Pinewood Derby Races so our scouts can have a fun time building their car and racing.

We have Packs in our district who have tracks and are willing to share their track or have other packs join them on their Derby Day.

Stones River Region, Murfreesboro Antique Automobile Club of America has purchased a metal track for the packs to use free of charge. The Club will deliver and set up the track. It is the packs responsibility to run their derby race and purchase their trophies and ribbons for the scouts.
